

JUNGLE ADVENTURE TOUR

5 DAYS



The 5-day tour is a wonderful canoe trip from the Cuyabeno Reserve (Ecuador) to the border with Peru. Passing through different rivers and lagoons, we travel through beautiful landscapes and observe a wide variety of wild animals, for example, monkeys, sloths, snakes, pink dolphins and caimans. We enter an area far from other tourist activities, inhabited only by indigenous communities. Spending the nights in cabins and tents in the middle of the jungle, we come into direct contact with nature.

- 10.30 Entrance to the Cuyabeno Reserve, observation of flora and fauna
- 13.00 Arrival at Macrolobium Lodge

- 16.30 Great Lagoon, swimming, sunset, observation of caimans, boas, etc.
- 19.30 Return to the lodge

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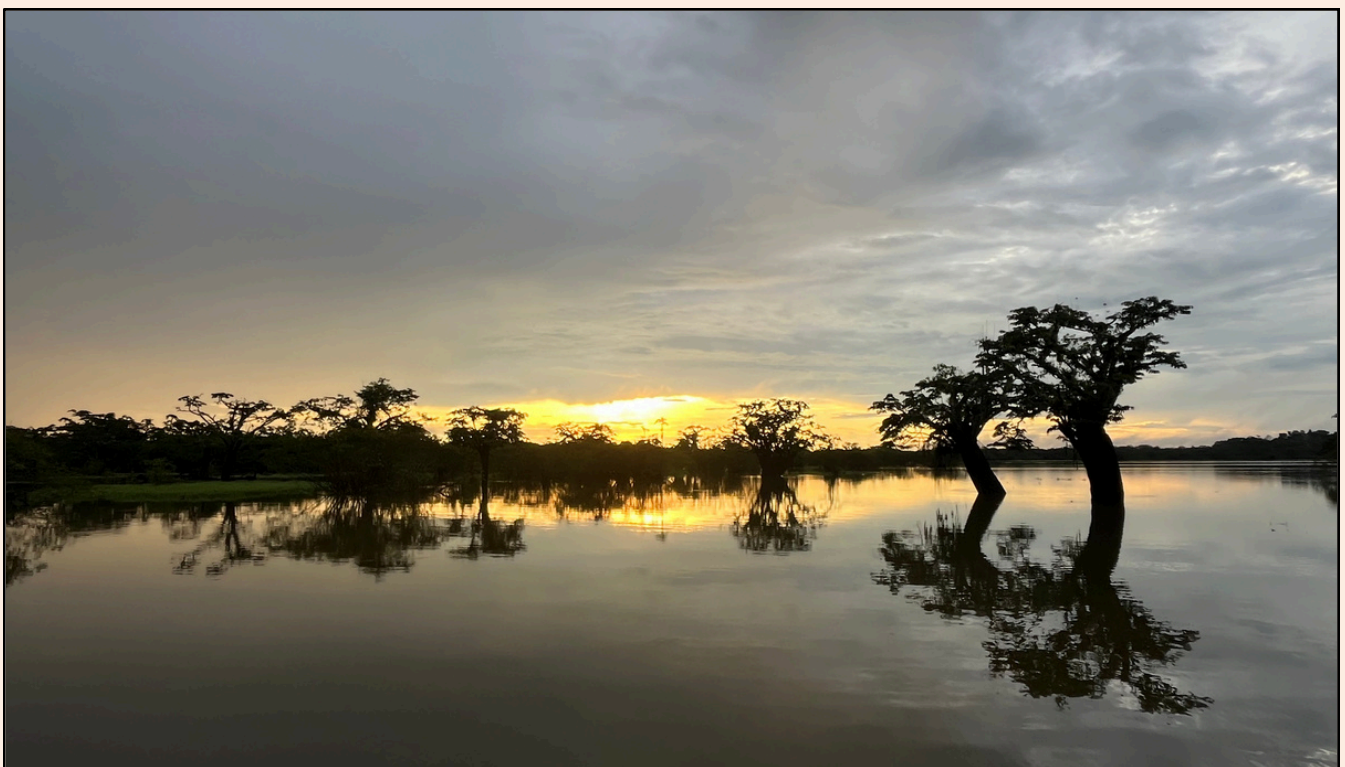


DAY 4

DAY 5

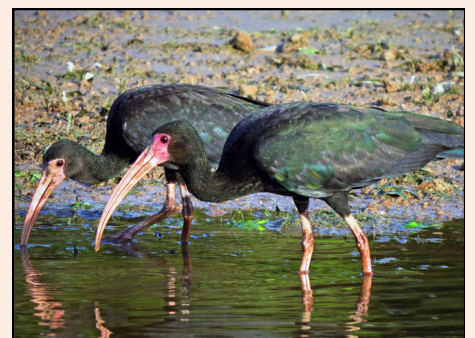
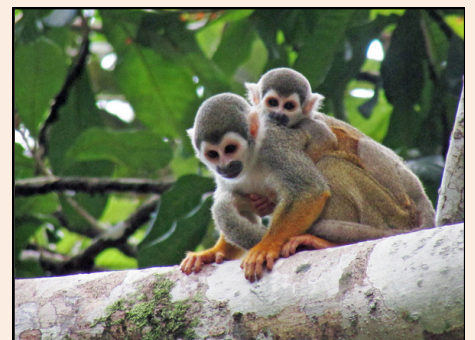
- 8.00 Breakfast
