

The 4-day tour is a wonderful journey by motorised and rowing canoe, from the Cuyabeno Reserve to the Aguarico River. Passing through different rivers and lagoons, we travel through beautiful landscapes and observe a wide variety of wild animals. For example, monkeys, sloths, snakes, pink dolphins and caimans. We enter an area far from other tourist activities, inhabited only by indigenous communities. Spending the nights in cabins and tents in the middle of the jungle, we come into direct contact with nature. The main attraction of this tour is the observation of the harpy eagle, one of the largest birds of prey in South America, in its nesting place.
